## Year 5 Harvest Church Service

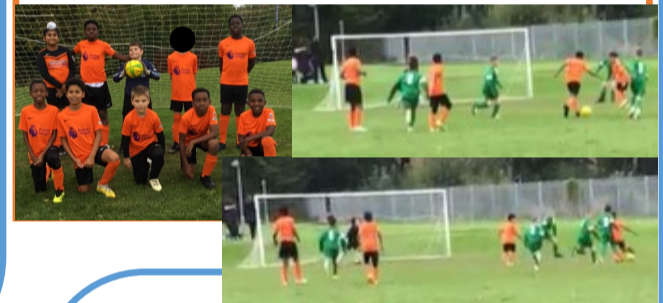
Year 5 performed a fantastic church service at St. Leonards, highlighting the importance of Harvest and how it can impact

## Macmillan Coffee Morning

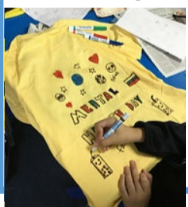
Children raised £420 in the Macmillan Coffee Morning on the 27th September.

Families kindly donated money to receive cakes and it was fantastic to see parents in attendance at the event.



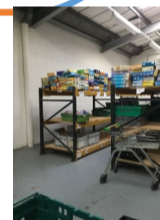
## Mental Health Day
