## vocabulary

1	Golf Club	A club used to hit the ball in golf, with a heavy wooden or metal head on a <u>slender</u> shaft.
2	Hole	A circular hole in the ground which is also called "the cup", 4.25 inches in diameter. Hole in One Getting the ball directly from the tee into the hole with one stroke.
3	Tee	In golf, a tee is the small wooden support off of which you hit a golf ball. The word tee is also used more generally for the area of a golf course where you begin a match.
4	Putter	A golfer who hits the ball very gently close to the hole is a putter. The club used to do this is also a putter.
5	Chip	A chip is a low shot that is played along the ground and spends little time in the air.
6	Striking	The ability to use an effective movement pattern to strike an object with an implement or the body is critical for successful performance.
7	Accuracy	Accuracy is the ability to perform movements and skills with precision. Quite often it is being able to direct an object to a small target area.
