

| 1 | Digital Photographs | An image produced using a digital camera and stored as an electronic file.  |

| 2 | Editing             | The changing of digital photographs using programs such as Photoshop, Gimp and Microsoft Paint.   |
| 3 | Layering            | Layering in digital art allows for the creation of a finished painting by stacking isolated passes of light, shadow, colour, and detail.  |
| 4 | Montage             | Various types of image editing in which multiple photographs are cut up and combined to form one new image.   |
| 5 | Re-create           | Making modifications which range from sharpening the image to drastically re-creating the image in assorted colours, arrangements, and even breaking the photograph down to multiple parts. |
| 6 | Cropping            | The act of improving an image by removing unnecessary parts.  |
| チ | Effects             | Change the appearance of an image by attempting to mimic art media like paint or pencil, add texture or create other changes like blurring.   |
