Game 1 Scoreboard

The first game that children played was scoreboard, each child in the team had one shot each to get the best score, out of 10. The arrow must stick on straight away and not just “bounce” off.

Game 3 Knockout

If a team finishes 4th, they get 5 points, if a team finishes 3rd they get 8 points if a team finishes second they get 10 points and finally, winning gets you 12 points.
