

Intra House Tri-Golf Y3/Y4

This Spring term, selected children from year 3 and 4 had taken part in a tri-golf interhouse tournament. This involved 5 children from each of the houses, Stonefield, St. Edwards, St Leonards and Hickman. Children were picked based on behaviour and opportunities, making sure that a range of children who don't normally favour PE to take part in something active and fun. Children from Year 6 helped out and became PE leaders, who took responsibility for a house and scoring their points as well as timing.

On the day, children participated in three different Tri-Golf games which tested different skills within the sport. One of the games tested their accuracy, and how many points they can score the fastest. One game relied on the amount of power put into a shot, and one game relied of accuracy and power. Within these games, children each had turns where they had to score for themselves for the team, or as a team collectively to score points.
