| 3 | Change | If you pay for items with coins or notes you may be given change if you have given too much money. E.g. if a lolly is 20p and you only have 50p, the shop keeper would give you 30p in change. |
| 4 | Amount | How much an item costs. |
| 5 | Card | Adults sometimes use a card to pay for items. On a card there is money which is take from your bank account when you pay. You use this instead of coins and notes. |
| 6 | Bank | The bank is where money is kept. |
| 7 | Buy | You can buy items in a shop with coins, notes or your card. |
