1	Coin	<p>1p 2p 5p 10p 20p 50p £1 £2 one penny two pence five pence ten pence twenty pence fifty pence one pound two pounds</p>
2	Note	<p>£5 £10 £20 £50 five pounds ten pounds twenty pounds fifty pounds</p>
3	Change	If you pay for items with coins or notes you may be given change if you have given too much money. E.g. if a lolly is 20p and you only have 50p, the shop keeper would give you 30p in change.
4	Amount	How much an item costs.
5	Card	Adults sometimes use a card to pay for items. On a card there is money which is taken from your bank account when you pay. You use this instead of coins and notes.
6	Bank	The bank is where money is kept.
7	Buy	You can buy items in a shop with coins, notes or your card.
