

Tri-Golf Competition 3&4

Selected children from Year 3 & 4 classes across the cohorts participated in an inter-house tri-golf competition. They competed in their houses against each other, across a series of tri-golf games using different clubs.



At first children played a game using putters, called finders keepers. The aim of this game was to try and hit as many cones as possible after hitting the ball. The cones or balls that you hit in one try you get to keep for your team, and are equivalent to different points. Each cone was worth one, and each ball was worth three.



Children carried on playing a series of games, and after the final games the scores were in!

Stonefield finished on 33 points, Hickman and St Edwards both finished on 45 points and St Leonards finished on 74 points.
